Bristol wide service changes – current position NHS Foundation Trust

| Timescale | Service change |
|---------------------------------------|---|
| 22 April 2014 | Transfer of inpatient paediatric services from Frenchay Hospital to Bristol Royal Hospital for Children |
| April 2014 | Transfer of South Gloucestershire Community Services from North Bristol Trust (NBT) to Sirona Care |
| 12 th May 2014 (two weeks) | NBT moves into the new hospital from the current Southmead and Frenchay facilities. |
| June 2014 | Transfer of Vascular services from the Bristol Royal Infirmary to the new Southmead Hospital. |
| July 2014 | Breast Screening Programme from University Hospitals Bristol NHS Foundation Trust (UH Bristol) to NBT. |
| June 2014 to Feb 2015 | UH Bristol BRI Internal Reconfiguration |
| August 2014 | South West Cleft Service transfers from NBT to UH Bristol |
| October 2014 | New providers for mental health services as part of Modernising Mental Health Programme |




