

BHOC Parking Permit

BHOC offers a parking permit for patients who are receiving regular treatment, or long or delayed treatments that go over 2 hours. This permit is then valid for 7 consecutive days.

- 1. After parking in our car park: please buy a parking ticket for 2 hours priced at £3.00 from the pay and display machine (price correct at time of printing February 2010). Clearly display this ticket in your car.
- 2. Go to main reception on the ground floor and ask the receptionist for a parking permit, giving them the following information:
 - a) that you have displayed your pay and display ticket
 - b) the patient's surname
 - c) the vehicle licence number
- 3. The receptionist will be able to give you more information about how the parking permit works.
