Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trusts response is as follows:

1) How many consultants do you employ on a permanent basis?

The Trust currently employs 445 permanent consultants

2) Of the consultants you employ on a permanent basis, how many of them do one or more session a week in the community? By session we mean an activity on the consultant job plan relating to direct clinical care. By community we mean a non-hospital medical setting, for example a community diabetes clinic. If it is not possible to provide me with all the data, please provide what data is available and within budget to source. For example, if the number of sessions a consultant does a week is not available, please provide me just with how many consultants you employ who have worked in the community at least once in the last year.

We do not hold this information as we do not have a central database for job plans.

This concludes our response. We trust that you find this helpful, but please do not hesitate to contact us directly if we can be of any further assistance.

If, after that, you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
