The following Clinical Staff require Resuscitation Training every two years.

Registered Nurses

Registered Midwives

Nursing & Midwifery Assistants

Assistant Practitioners

Established Medical Staff (Consultants & Staff & Associate Specialist grades)

Junior Doctors including Clinical Fellows

Operating Department Practitioners

Physiotherapists

Radiographers

Occupational Therapists

Cardiac Physiologists & Technicians

Nutrition & Dietetics

Speech & Language Therapists
