1. Do you have a fracture clinic service at your trust?

Yes. The Trust runs a fracture clinic in the Bristol Royal Infirmary on a daily basis (Monday to Friday)

2. If so, do you have a fracture liaison nurse, or fracture liaison services for your patients?

Yes, The Trust does have nurse practitioners that work within the fracture clinic.

3. If so, is this commissioned by the the acute trust, or the CCG?

Please be advised that all services are commissioned by the CCG through our contract negotiations. Please note this service is not sub-contracted to another provider, we provide this service directly.
