Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trusts response is as follows:

**Please provide the following figures for each calendar year from 2013 to 2017:**

- 1) The number of A&E attendances where the word 'cocaine' appears in the free-text diagnosis field.**

We are unable to provide the requested information as this is recorded in free-text field and the data we can obtain from it would be likely to underestimate the involvement of the drugs listed as multiple drugs may be involved.

- 2) The number of A&E attendances where the word 'ecstasy' appears in the free-text diagnosis field.**

We are unable to provide the requested information – see response to question one.

- 3) The number of A&E attendances where the word 'ketamine' appears in the free-text diagnosis field.**

We are unable to provide the requested information - see response to question one.

- 4) The number of A&E attendances diagnosed as F14 under the ICD-10 classification system.**

We do not hold this information. Please note the Trust has only just commenced use of diagnoses in ED and these are SNOMED not ICD10. Please also note only patients admitted to beds will have full diagnosis (ICD10) recording.

- 5) The number of A&E attendances diagnosed as F15 under the ICD-10 classification system.**

We do not hold this information. Please see response to question four.

- 6) The number of A&E attendances diagnosed as F16 under the ICD-10 classification system.**

We do not hold this information. Please see response to question four.
