Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trusts response is as follows:

In the 12 months to 30 April 2017:

How many non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC) patients were treated?	661	
How many NSCLC patients were treated surgically?	233	
How many NSCLC patients were treated within the 31 day target for the first treatment?	439	95.6%
How many NSCLC patients were treated within 62 days of urgent GP referral?	136	54.2%
How many NSCLC patients were treated under joint responsibility with North Bristol NHS Trust (NBNHST)?	119	
How many patients treated under joint responsibility with NBNHST were treated within the 31 day target for the first treatment?	111	93.3%
How many patients treated under joint responsibility with NBNHST were treated within 62 days of urgent GP referral?	46	53.5%
How many NSCLC patients treated under joint responsibility with NBNHST were treated surgically (first treatment)?	51	
How many NSCLC patients treated surgically (first treatment) under joint responsibility with NBNHST were treated within the 31 day target for the first treatment?	45	88.2%
How many NSCLC patients treated surgically (first treatment) under joint responsibility with NBNHST were treated within 62 days of urgent GP referral	14	36.8%
