
## Partnership Plan

## **HCV Service Treatment Provider Map**



- The current partnership model centres on the well-established secondary care HCV treatment providers in our ODN (as described above), with the Bristol-led MDT established as host/lead since July 2014.
- Outreach/non-specialised service provision is now being delivered by University Hospitals Bristol NHS FT, Royal United Hospitals Bath NHS FT and Gloucester Royal Hospitals NHS FT, with the majority of outreach services being delivered by the Bristol hub. We continue to expand and develop our outreach services as we advance our relationships with stakeholders involved in the care of HCV patients. We are planning to enable treatment to be delivered at Southmead Hospital shortly, having received outline approval from NHSE in March 2019.
- The current ODN treatment provider teams recognise that a unified referral pathway for each centre will be helpful to facilitate uptake of treatment beyond secondary care with an e-referral pathway currently in development. Once finalised this will be published on our new ODN website which can be freely accessed by all healthcare and non-healthcare providers.
- We have engaged well with allied support agencies, which takes place at the local level of each of the specialised secondary care treatment providers, to be initiated by the HCV clinical leads (see 5-year plan in appendix two). We plan to improve

engagement with the CCGs, and have been in contact with the local Bristol CCG regarding progressing this.
