- Who is your current Intraocular lens provider/providers? Alcon through NHSSC.
- How long will your future Intraocular tender contract run for? N/A.
- What is the value of your current Intraocular Lens Contract? N/A.
- What is the price of your most used IOL? Approximately £80-£120.
- Do you use Toric Lenses for NHS patients or for private? The Trust uses some Toric lenses for NHS patients according to clinical need.
- Who is your current Toric Lens supplier? Alcon.
- Do you have a Toric pathway? Per individual patient.
- What is the price of your most used Toric IOL? This is not a frequent purchase, therefore we can't provide any meaningful data.
