Thank you for your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Trust's response is as follows:

- Does your Trust routinely offer Mass Spectrometry testing for Diagnostic purposes? (please answer either yes or no to this question). Yes.
- If you answered yes to question 1, can you please provide a list of which assays / tests are routinely run on the Mass Spectrometry system in your Trust.
 Organic Acids in urine, cortisol in saliva & urine, vitamin D in plasma.
- Does your Trust send away samples (to locations outside of your trust) for Mass Spectrometry testing? (please answer either yes or no to this question). Yes.
- 4. If you answered yes to question 3, can you please list the assays / tests which are run on the samples you send away? Please see the attached document (19-571 External Laboratories). This is a list of all laboratories and associated tests for samples referred for testing. Methodology information will need to be sought directly from these service providers.
